Two killed in police custody in Bihar

Two persons died in police custody on Wednesday night, allegedly due to police torture, in Sitamarhi district. Subsequently, a magisterial probe has been ordered into their deaths. Eight police personnel have been suspended for dereliction of duty. "Since the suspects died in police custody, the directive of the national human rights commission will be followed. Action will be taken as per law," DIG Ravinder Kumar said.
