# SUB: - ANNOUNCEMENT OF ONLINE SHORT - TERM INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME FROM

#### April 18 - May 2, 2022

The National Human Rights Commission has expressly been mandated to promote Human Rights literacy and awareness vide Section 12 (h) of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993. With a view to spread awareness among University students about the need for protection and promotion of Human Rights, the Commission has been regularly conducting *Internship Programmes'* since 1998.

- 2. For the Month of April, 2022 the "Online Short Term Internship Programme April, 2022 (OSTI- APRIL 2022)" will commence from 18th April, 2022 (Monday) to 2nd May, 2022 (Monday) (15 days). Applications are invited from eligible students of the entire country. Eligibility and selection criteria will be as follows:-
  - (i) Students studying in 3rd year and onwards of any integrated 5 year PG Course
  - (ii) Students studying in 3rd/final year of graduation course
  - (iii) Students of any semester/year of any post-graduate degree course
  - (iv) Students of any semester/ year of any post-graduate diploma course
  - (v) Students who are research scholars in any stream.
- 3. Students must have consistently attained a <u>minimum of 60% marks in Class XII</u> and all subsequent courses (all semesters) including the presently <u>pursued courses</u>. The calculated percentage has to be mentioned clearly from their CGPA/SGPA alongwith the formula for percentage obtained. Failure to do either of it so would result in rejection of application form.
- 4. Co-curricular activities, internships, moot court participation, successful research projects undertaken, work/projects with NGOs are the few illustrated criteria for enhancing the chances of selection.
- 5. A 250 words write-up on the topic "Statement of Purpose for joining NHRC Online Short Term Internship" will be required to be submitted by the applicants online along with the application form which will also serve as a basis of selection. Students who have research potential in the areas relating to human rights will be preferred (to be indicated in the write-up).

6. <u>Enclose Self attested scanned copies of mark-sheet from 12<sup>th</sup> Standard onwards and mark-sheet of each year/semester of presently pursuing course</u> (and recommendation by concerned HOD/Dean/Principal which should be of a date subsequent to the date of uploading of this advertisement and for the presently pursued course).

#### 7. In absence of following, the applications are liable to be rejected.

- i. Scanned Self attested mark-sheets from 12th Standard onwards
- ii. Scanned Statement of Purposes (SOPs) and
- iii. Scanned Recommendation letter/email by HOD/Dean/Principal concerned in the annexed Proforma.
- 8. Students who have attended earlier Internship Programmes organized by NHRC will not be eligible to apply.
- 9. This is a <u>full time Internship Programme from 10:00 am to 5:30 pm</u> (Monday to Friday). Students must ensure about their availability before applying. The student <u>should not be more than 28 years old as on 1st January, 2022.</u>
- 10. <u>Brief Course Structure of Online Short Term Internship April 18 May 2, 2022 would be as stated below-</u>

**About 50** sessions on various human rights issues are proposed to be covered to sensitize the interns. The Online SIP 2022 will include following inputs:

- Address/Interaction with Hon'ble Chairperson and Members of NHRC and other domain Experts including senior Govt. of India Officials.
- Group Project work on Human Right issues.
- Book Review to be submitted by the students
- Films on Human Rights & Discussion Child and Bonded Labour issues, Anti Trafficking, Health including mental health and Education issues and discussions.
- Virtual Field Visit
  - Virtual visit to Jail
  - Virtual field visit to Police Station
  - Virtual field visit to NGO

The students get to see the working of these institutions and may get their related questions addressed.

#### 11. AWARD

- All the student interns successfully completing the internship would receive a stipend of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only)
- Certificate of participation will be awarded to the candidates on the basis of following parameters:

Attendance, Punctuality, Discipline, Participation in online sessions is mandatory; Project Presentation & Project Reports and Book Review have to be submitted timely.

The last date for submission of the application is 3rd April, 2022 (11:59PM). The 'Application Form' for Short Term Internship Programme- April, 2022 is available at link 'Online Short Term Internship'. All the applications should be submitted through this online platform only.

13. Please ensure that the application for OSTI April, 2022 is duly filled. Applications submitted otherwise will not be accepted.

Kindly note → Incomplete applications / applications without self attested copies of mark-sheets, Letter of recommendation & SOPs etc. will be rejected and Applications sent through e-mails/posts will not be entertained. No application will be accepted after the deadline i.e. 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2022 (11:59pm).
