 Human Rights Act, 1993.
- ii. To review the existing government policies, laws, rules, orders, etc., relating to the Older Persons from the perspective of human rights and make suggestions/recommendations for change or for their better implementation.
- iii. To identify best practices, policies and programs nationally and internationally adopted to protect the rights of Older Persons.
- 4- The Core Group will meet periodically at regular intervals as and when deemed necessary.
- 5- The participating members of the Core Group shall be entitled to an honorarium of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) and local transportation of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only). The members outside Delhi shall also be entitled for reimbursement of the economy class air fare for the to-&-fro journey undertaken by them to attend the Core Group meetings.
