Sub: Recommendation based on the visit report of Dr. Vinod Aggarwal, Special Rapporteur, NHRC to Lohardaga ,Jharkhand to evaluate the implementation of MG NREGA Scheme on 10th January, 2020.

Dr. Vinod Aggarwal, Special Rapporteur visited the Lohardaga state of Jharkhand on 10th January, 2020 to study the implementation of the MG NREGA scheme. He has submitted a general report regarding the realization of rural development schemes and how it has benefitted the agricultural labourers belonging to schedule caste and schedule tribe.

The observations and recommendations that emerged from the visit are mentioned below:

Observations/ Key Information obtained:

1. Population figures:

- i. Lohardaga, Jharkhand has population of 0.46 million out of which 0.40 million population resides in rural area and 13% in the urban area. Further, 3.4% are SCs (15330) and 56.89 % are STs (262734).
- ii. The number of marginal farmers as per 'District Agricultural Data' is 7903 families and number of agricultural laborers is 9127 respectively.

2. Man-days targets:

- The man-days target is 13.68 Lakh for the current financial year 2019 -20. As against the expected man-days target of 10.5 lakh to be achieved till January, 2020. However, the target is low but it can be considered satisfactory.
- II. The district has 7 blocks and till 10th January, 2020 69 % i.e. 6.89 lakh man days were created.
- III. Out of total man days generated in the current financial year, STs have done 4,27,744 (62%) of total man days and contribution to weaker section is about 62%.

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- IV. The distribution of MG NREGA scheme states that the district has not increased beyond 83% of the target man days in last 6 years whereas in the year 2018-19 the achievement remained 75% only.
- V. One of the reasons for this could be the substantial difference in wages paid by labour department and wages paid by NREGA. Another reason could be the strike in the year 2018 by NREGA personnel and shortage of funds. More clarifications on the reasons for non-achievement of targets and relook into uniformity in work demanded of each labourer in all states are required.

3. Wages:

- i. In the year 2018-19, 77% of the payment is Adhaar based as the 87% Adhaar cards were linked and verified i.e. 63995 verified cards out of 73195.
- ii. In the year 2018-19, 90% of wages have been paid within 8 days of generation of muster roll and 8% of wages have been released within 15 days. However, 2% of wages has been paid after 15 days. Therefore, there is a need to examine these cases by the senior officer.

4. Job cards:

- i. The number of job cards produced in the year 2014 (68723) has increased to 73597 by the end of year 2018.
- ii. The number of active job cards in the year 2014 (63813) reduced to 47667 in the year 2018.
- iii. Out of 93% active job cards produced in the year 2014 only 65% job cards are active by the end of 2019.

5. Expenditure:

- i. In the financial year 2018-19 the total expenditure is close to the expenditure of the year 2017-18 i.e. 29 Cr.
- ii. The efficiency of DC and DDC appointed at NRM has increased from 60% to 75% in the year 2018-19 compared to the year 2014 and 2015.
- **6.** In Geo tagging the performance of the Lohardaga district is excellent i.e. 93-94%. Also, high degree of Geo tagging will help in elimination of a scheme if taken up again, as the work can't be same for the similar work at same time.

Recommendations:

- 1. There is a need to prepare a report mentioning work distribution among SC and ST under the MG NREGA scheme.
- 2. The wages of MG-NREGA in-charge may be enhanced to commensurate with their responsibility as wages are too low to command in respect of his subordinates.
- 3. In the year 2015-16, only 2879 families were given 100 man days which is a best figure in the last 5 years. It is, therefore suggested that families getting 100 days (full employment) be raised to at least Rs. 5000/- as against more than 47, 667 families having Active cards in the district.
- 4. There is a need to make appropriate assessment of the administrative expenditure s in the current financial year 2019-20 in comparison last 5 years.

Shri Jaideep Govind Secretary General, NHRC Report 2, on Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MG:NREGA), in Lohardaga district of the state of Jharkhand by Dr. Vinod Aggarwal, Sp. Rapporteur, NHRC on 10th Jan, 2020.

The implementation of this rural employment scheme was examined in the district of Lohardaga on 10thJan, 20. The population of the district is about 0.461 million. It is mainly rural district with 13 % population is urban & 0.404 million population is rural. The 3.4% population belongs to SC and 56.89 % are ST. In the area about 15330SC and 262734 ST live and also there are 9127 rural households, who are agricultural laborers. The number of marginal farmers, as per district agricultural data, is 38528 families. The number of small farmers as per district agricultural deta, is 7903 families. Even many of these small cultivators, sometimes there is not enough work, in their own fields, and they may also like to take up work under MG NREGA. In this district although there are many Alumina mines, but still large rural population, is still dependent on work in MG NREGA to keep the wage rate stable.

Number of registered families with family job cards is 68723 in 2014, which increased marginally to 73597 in 2018. The active job cards were 63813 in 2014 which got reduced to 47667 in 2018. Out of the families having the job card made,93% job cards were active in 2014, but now only 65% are and done work for at least one day in the previous year. In the current financial year the man days employment has been provided for 13.68lakh man days, against which the proportionate target till January, 20 is 10.51lakh man days For population of 4 lakh, this target of 1.36 million man days seems low but satisfactory. If100 man days are given to 13600 families can be fully satisfied. It is felt that man days target of less than 2 million man days may give job guarantee slightly larger number of agricultural laborers. The district has 7 blocks and till the date of visit, 6.89 lakh man days (66%) of the proportionate target were created in the current year. Out of total man days generated the ST have done 427744 man days which is about 62% of total man days. The population of STs 57% and contribution to man days by this weaker section is about 62%. This suggests that without fixing the target, the STs have got 8-9% more man days per head. Similarly SCs constitute 3.4% rural population but have got 5% man days. They are also getting higher man days automatically, to the tune of about 50%. The district authorities have no data about the employment given to the agricultural land less labors and marginal farmers.

The disturbing feature of the district MG NREGA is that the district has not gone beyond 83% of the target in any year in last 6 years although they were able to achieve at least 75% all of the years. In the year of 2018, there were reasons of strike for not achieving the target but otherwise not achieving the target in a poor

able to achieve at least 75% all of the years. In the year of 2018, there were reasons of strike for not achieving the target but otherwise not achieving the target in a poor district. In the year 18-19, the achievement remained at 75% only. The performance of various blocks in achievement of man-days varied from 71 to 82% and no one is too down below or too much to brag about. On the point of timely payment 77% of the payment is Aadhaar based in the year 2018-19. The reason seems to be that 87% of the Aadhaar linked cards are verified. Thus 63997 cards are Aadhaar verified out of 73195 cards which are linked to Aadhaar. On timely payment in 18-19, 90% of wages have been paid within 8 days of generation of muster roll. The 8% payment has been released in 15 days. Therefore only 2% of wages has gone beyond 15 days. The cases where payment has not been released within 15 days must be examined by senior officers. Kisko and Bandara block has done very well who has done about 97% in 8 days and 2-3% in 15 days. Overall Kuru block was too much behind where 7% people have got their wages after 15 days and the local officers may be taken to task.

In the financial year 18-19 the total expenditure is of 29 Cr rupee, which is almost same as 17-18. The DC and DDC pointed at NRM work increased in 18-19 to 77%, which was earlier at a slightly lower level than 60% in the years of 2014, 2015 and 2018. In the pendency of the schemes the district has shown a poor performance especially in the year of 2013-16 when very few schemes got completed. 13407 schemes were taken upfrom 2013 to 2018 and out of them 10809 schemes remained incomplete. There need to be a major drive for completion of pending schemes and some sort of embargo on taking up of new schemes is required

In Geo tagging the performance of the district is excellent and generally above 93-94%. High degree of geo –tagging will help in elimination a scheme being taken again, because the place can't be same for to similar work at one site.

Recommendations:

- 1. The rural population of the district is quite big and STs in rural area are 2.63 lakhs and constitute 56% population of the district. The active cards are 47667 look reasonable, but a certificate from all SC, ST, and rural land less families in the district may be obtained whether they are getting sufficient work under MG NREGA or not? Now a stage has come when we should start finding from the beneficiaries whether they are ready to work or not.
- 2. The district administration gave information of 2879 families been given 100 days in 15-16 as a best figure in last 5 years, for the families getting full 100 days employment. It is felt that this figure should

- touch 5000 families as active card holder families are more than 47667 families, seeking employment from the district in last 5 years.
- 3. Administrative expenditure is within 6%. In the year 2013-14, it has been reported less than 0.6% which doesn't seems correct. This was asked of them but no plausible reason was given for such a low expenditure. The wages of the Block in charge of NREGA program is too low to command the respect from Class 3 staff (PanchayatSevak) and others. It is strongly felt that, even if these are on contract, there salary should be more respectful and commensurate their responsibility.
- 4. When Aadhaar verification is quite high of 87% and the Aadhaar payment is reasonable at about 77%. The reasons informed by the DC is that there are more than one account opened for the beneficiary and the system finally captures only one of those accounts and if the beneficiary has more accounts and funds gets transferred in any one of the accounts, than it is not reflected in the Aadhaar based payment, there is an issue that needs investigation so that all the accounts of the beneficiary should be reflected or the money be transferred in the earmarked account only. It seems some sort of software changes are required for which a higher level inter action is required.
- 5. The number of incomplete works is about 51% as on 31-3-2019. In Senha block the % of incomplete works increases to 61% and in Lohardaga block, the pending works are 32% only. It is required that the administration conducts an audit and see that schemes more than 3 years old are either completed or foreclosed on an early date or in the current financial year 2019-20.
- 6. It is prescribed that 60% expenditure should be due on NRM (Natural Resource Management), but in financial reports of 3 years it was not reflected. In the district the NRM works expenditure in last 5, for 3 years work account for more than 60%. It may be explained by the district authorities. About the percentage of expenditure is being maintained or not and NRM expenditure should remain between 58-62% over the years not as wide a variation as seen.
- 7. The man day target of 1.3 million seems to be reasonable but needs increase to 2 million and at least 5000 families should complete 100 days of employment. But district has not achieved the mandays target even once in last 5-6 years, therefore it is felt that the target raising has to be based on

further assessment of the capacity of the personal and it seems the rate are low in MG NREGA, which may not be encouraging for workers to work whole heartedly.

8. The wages given under MG NREGA be increased so that there ratio is maintained at the same differential from minimum wages in the area, which was about 5 years back. That will also encourage more workers to come forward for MG NREGA works.
