- 2. The terms of reference of the Core Group on Women are as under:
 - 2.1. To advise the Commission on issues relating to availability, affordability and accessibility of health care to the people in India. These issues may include the references made by the Commission to the Core Group and any other issue, which the Members of the Core Group consider it appropriate to suggest to the Commission in the light of the relevant provisions of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993;
 - 2.2. To review the Government laws, policies, rules, orders, etc, concerning health and mental health and related matters from human rights perspective and to make suggestions for changes for their better implementation;
 - 2.3. To suggest on the possibility as well as plan of action for making health care a justiciable and enforceable right in the country:
 - 2.4. To identify best practices relating to the issues of health and mental healthcare in India and abroad and to recommend for their implementation in different States/Union Territories of the country:
 - 2.5. To identify any other important issue concerning right to health and mental healthcare and to suggest measures for better implementation;
 - 2.6. To study the problem of rehabilitation of patients who are cured from mental health illness and to suggest course of action;
 - 2.7. To study issues related to mental health including the adequacy of infrastructure and manpower in this area.
- 3. The Core Group will meet as and when deemed necessary, in the Commission.
- The participating Members of the Core Group shall be entitled for an honorarium of Rs. 2000/- and local transportation of Rs. 1000/-. The Members based outside Delhi shall also be entitled for reimbursement of economy class air fare (by Air India) for the to and fro journey undertaken by them in connection with the Core Group meetings.
